Dear brethren,

Christian Greetings! **April 13<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup>, 2024 is designated as Literature Evangelism Rally Week.**

During this week, each member is encouraged to do the following:

1. **Purchase at least one book from one of our Literature Evangelists** (a payment plan can be worked out)
2. **Read an SDA book**
3. **Distribute a piece of literature (Book, Magazine, Leaflet, etc.) Each day of the week.**
4. **Distribute to your social media contacts the electronic version of the Great Controversy** (which we will send to you)
5. **Distribute and study the electronic guide to The Great Controversy Book** (which we will send to you)

The week will climax on **Sabbath 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 with the Literature Evangelists Day.** This day should be used to highlight the important work of our Literature Evangelists (Colporteurs) and to encourage members to get involve in distributing the printed pages.

We trust that you will find this week very rewarding as we continue to share the good news through the printed pages!

**Not to be Read to the Church (for the consideration of the above-named leaders)**

1. **Promote and distribute** the above letter on all your church chats.
2. **Look out for the electronic copy of the Great Controversy book and its study guide** and distribute them to the members so that they can distribute and study this book electronically.

3. **A sermon will be sent** to you that should be used during the preaching service at your congregation on **Sabbath 13<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2024**. Use it wisely and tailor it to suite your context.
4. Work along with the Pastor, the Head Elder, the Personal Ministries Leaders, the Head Sabbath School Superintendent and the Head AY Leader to ensure that this initiative takes place. **Collaboration is highly recommended.**
5. Where the local congregation has an elected Publishing Secretary and/or an active Literature Evangelist, they should team up to implement this initiative. Where the church has neither, the pastor and or the Head Elder should lead out in this initiative.
6. This is a time to ensure that **all the magazines and books that are packed up in your vestries are gathered, sorted out and placed in the hands of the members** so that they can have a variety of literature to give out each day of the week. You may purchase additional literature if you deem it necessary.
7. Having understood the essence of the initiative and what is intended to happen, take it and work it in the best possible way. You can shift around an item or two or you can add your own creative ideas. But do something during this week and on **Sabbath 20<sup>th</sup>, April, 2024**.
8. **Come up with a simple reporting system and send to us at the Conference Publishing Department a brief report and two of your best pictures** that highlight the work that was done during that week. (you can consider number of magazines distributed, number of books distributed, number of electronic Great Controversy book shared, number of electronic Great Controversy study guide distributed, how many persons have begun studying this book with other persons, etc.)
9. This can be an ongoing initiative at your local congregation and it can fit in very well with the **'All the Family in Mission'** initiative
